

SUMMARIES IN ENGLISH

1. SPEECH BY DR. LE MANH HUNG, ACTING DIRECTOR GENERAL, GENERAL STATISTICAL OFFICE, AT THE 45TH ANNIVERSARY OF ESTABLISHMENT OF STATISTICAL BRANCH

After reviewing the process of formation, establishment and development from initial establishment days to now, the speech highlights important achievements gained during the last 45 years as well as shortcomings that need to be overcome in coming years. In addition, lessons were drawn and concrete directions for branch development in coming years were proposed.

2. DISCUSSION ON BASIC ISSUES IN CALCULATING THE BOND PRICE INDEX

Bond is one of the stocks recently appearing in Vietnam. Markets decide the price of bond and it is a timing indicator and always changing. The bond price index is a "health-measuring thermometer" of an economy in general and a company in particular.

The article mentions basic issues used to calculate the bond price index, in which the author gives notes on prices, weights and detailed computational procedures.

3. STATISTICS OF NATIONAL WEALTH IN SNA
